► Annual General Meeting

This year, the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of ENSA will be held in **Dublin, Ireland** from **October 21st to 25th**, 2014. One of the most important roles of ENSA is to be a **network between nursing students in Europe** - and by joining this AGM you will take part in this network. Each year the Board of ENSA decides on main topics that will be discussed at the AGM. This year, we will be focusing on the **importance of men in nursing**. This is a very important topic recently highlighted in nursing education and nursing practice across Europe.

This AGM will be an important milestone in ENSA's history because from now on ENSA will have the chance of becoming the voice of nursing students across Europe through EFN (European Federation of Nurses Association). Therefore, one of our other themes in this AGM is going to be **"ENSA - An organisation in the making"**.

► ENSA is on Its Way to Becoming a Legal Organisation

The Board of ENSA has had its **mid-term meeting in Brussels** between April 9th and 11th, 2014. During the mid-term meeting, **the Board of ENSA presented ENSA and its main goals in the General Assembly of the European Federation of Nurses Association (EFN)**.

During the meeting, the Board of ENSA met with Paul De Raeve (*the general secretary of EFN*) and discussed how ENSA could be the voice of nursing students all over Europe and take part in European Health Projects. Over the years ENSA has been invited to take part in important projects and discussions, but haven't officially been able to do because ENSA has not been a legal organization. Therefore the main outcome of this meeting was that: **"ENSA should become a legal organization"**.

On May 27, 2014, ENSA did an **Online Extraordinary General Assembly** with its members. Delegates representing nursing student from **Germany, France, Sweden and Turkey** attended the online meeting and voted for following questions:

1. Do you want ENSA to become a registered and legal organization?
2. Is it OK for you that the Board of ENSA makes necessary changes on the constitution to make the legalisation possible?




